Documents to be prepared by the applicant

- o **Valid passport** (with 2 blank pages)
- Valid long-term visa OR long-term/permanent residence permit of the Czech Republic
 - the visa / residence permit has to be valid after the return to the Czech Republic
- o 1 visa application form: https://www.mofa.go.jp/files/000124525.pdf
- o **1 photo** (Czech standard passport-size: 35 x 45 mm, not older than 6 months)
- Employment (or School Enrolment) certificate (in English or with English translation, the translation doesn't have to be official)
- Letter of mission or business trip order (by employer, in English)
 - information on who'll be covering the costs of the trip should be included in the document
 - employment certificate and letter of mission can be merged into one document
- o **Return air ticket reservation** (with name, arrival and departure dates)

All documents for the visa application must not be older than 3 months since the date of their issue (except for the passport, visa/residence permit and photo).
