

This information is for person(s) transiting in Japan.

- For nationals of non-visa exemption countries and regions, please **contact your airline(s)** to confirm whether or not you will go through the Customs and Immigration area at the transferring airport. If you do, you most likely need a transit visa. If not, then you do not need a transit visa.
- The Embassy may require you to obtain a short-term visa instead of a transit visa depending on your purpose to visit Japan. (You **MUST** apply for a short-term visit visa if you visit your family or friends in Japan even if your stay is less than 24 hours.)

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- **Valid passport** (with 2 blank pages)
- **Valid long-term visa OR long-term/permanent residence permit of the Czech Republic**
- **Visa application forms:** <https://www.mofa.go.jp/files/000124525.pdf>
- \* **Nationals of Russia and CIS countries are required to submit two application forms attached with a photo.**
- **1x photo** (Czech standard passport-size: 35 x 45 mm, not older than 6 months)
- **Visa for the final destination of your journey**
- **Flight itinerary**  
*must include at least flight reservations for the whole trip*
- **Hotel reservation in case you are staying at a hotel in Japan**

**Please submit all documents in English or Japanese).**

**During the application procedure, additional documents may be requested  
if deemed necessary.**

**The visa procedure takes about 1 week.**
