

List of basic documents to be submitted for a visa application

Embassy of Japan in Prague

For nationals of CIS countries and Georgia

Short-term visa for the purpose of tourism

Please **do NOT** staple/clip/tab the documents

Each applicant must submit each own set of documents

We **do NOT** make copies

Documents to be prepared by the applicant

- **Valid passport** (with 2 blank pages)
- **Copy of passport** (personal information page)
- **Copy of valid long-term visa OR long-term/permanent residence permit of the Czech Republic**
 - *the visa / residence permit has to be valid after the return to the Czech Republic*
- **2 visa application forms:** <https://www.mofa.go.jp/files/000124525.pdf>
 - ❖ Please type or print legibly in black/blue ink (not pencil).
 - ❖ Please do not leave any questions blank (Please write N/A if the question does not apply to you).
 - ❖ Your signature must match your passport signature.
- **2 photos** (Czech standard passport-size: 35 x 45 mm, not older than 6 months)
- **Travel itinerary (Day to Day Schedule):**

- **Return air ticket reservation** (with name, arrival and departure dates)
- **Copy of your passport (page with biometric data)**
- **For spouse and children applicants:**
 - Copy of Marriage Certificate w/ Translation
 - Copy of Birth Certificate w/ Translation
 - Sponsorship Letter
- **Documents to prove ability to pay for travel expenses**
 - *bank account statements for the last 3 months*

- *name of the account owner, transaction history, initial and final balances must be clearly visible*

Please submit all documents in English or Japanese (or with respective translations).

Bank account statements are accepted in Czech.

Please submit a set of documents for each applicant. You may not share your documents. We do not make copies.

During the application procedure, additional documents may be requested if deemed necessary.

The visa procedure takes about 1 week.

All documents for the visa application must not be older than 3 months since the date of their issue (except for the passport, visa/residence permit and photo).
